The German name of this village was the source of a famous South Tyrolean band's name: the Kastelruther Spatzen. One of the three largest villages along the Alpe di Siusi (Seiser Alm) Road, Castelrotto is known for its very tall church bell tower and its little Kofel Hill. Castelrotto is very popular with tourists due to its scenic beauty.
