

# District of Stufels

## Description

When today's Bressanone (Brixen) was first documented as Prihsna in 901, the district of Stufels had already been inhabited for thousands of years. Excavations have shown that there were settlements as far back as the Stone Age at this strategically important location along the routes over the Alps. The Romans also maintained farmsteads here, and probably a road station. Modern-day development of Stufels goes as far back as the Middle Ages, and as a result the district is almost entirely under protection as a monument. This is a real jewel of medieval architecture.
