

Runkelstein Castle

Description

Runkelstein Castle is situated in a mediaeval village that houses the largest non-religious cycle of frescoes that has survived to this day. The castle is located near Bolzano, on a rock facing onto the River Talvera, at the mouth of the Val Sarentino. The complex is made up of the castle itself and a large neighbourhood below, and has conserved its mediaeval character intact.
